Procedures

- In the event of severe weather or other unforeseen circumstance refer to Great Tew School's website initially. Our setting will aim to provide the same service as the School.
- Follow the link to Great Tew Pre-School to see our settings decision on whether to open or not.
- In the event of snow/ice/extreme weather, we endeavour to open the setting, possibly by using available 4x4's to ferry staff in. Should this be the case, we will inform Parents on our website that road conditions will be hazardous, and that they may wish not to make the journey.
- The setting will not invoice for sessions where the setting has remained closed. Whole sessions will be invoiced for even if we have not opened for a full session. Our costs remain the same regardless.
- Pre-School staff will be paid for their contracted hours should the Supervisor and Committee agree to close the setting.
